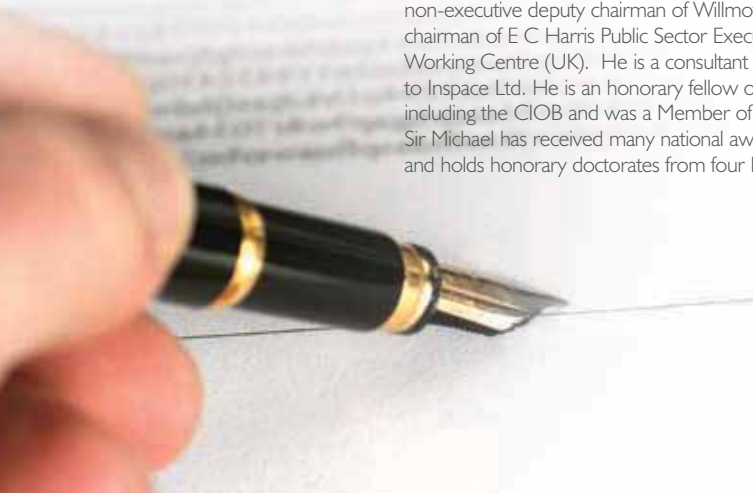
Sir Michael Latham: 'Potential Changes to the Construction Act Relating to Adjudication'

Prof. Rudi Klein: 'Making the Adequate Payment Mechanism'

This event provides the opportunity to hear two very eminent speakers and enjoy a panel debate. Questions will be taken from the floor. A light buffet and refreshments will be available.

Professor Rudi Klein has represented the legal and contractual interests of the specialist engineering sector in many forums including the Joint Contracts Tribunal where he was a member of the Drafting Sub-Committee for eight years. He represented the specialist contracting sector on the Latham Working Group 10 dealing with the reform of liability law and was actively involved in the piloting of the "Construction Act" through Parliament. In 2003 he briefed the House of Commons Trade and Industry Committee on the practice of retentions and in April 2006 he was appointed chairman of the New Engineering Contract (NEC) Users' Panel. Professor Klein is an honorary member of the Society of Construction Law, a Special Fellow of the CIOB and an adjudicator on the CIOB's Adjudication Panel.

Sir Michael Latham is author of the highly influential joint government/industry report *Constructing the Team* (1994). He is chairman of the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) and the Construction Skills Sector Council, non-executive deputy chairman of Willmott Dixon and non-executive chairman of E C Harris Public Sector Executive and the Collaborative Working Centre (UK). He is a consultant on partnering and best practice to Inspace Ltd. He is an honorary fellow of eight professional institutions, including the CIOB and was a Member of Parliament from 1974 to 1992. Sir Michael has received many national awards for his services to the industry and holds honorary doctorates from four British universities.
